**Abstract**

On August 7, 2020 Air India Express Limited VT-AXH crashed after landing at 19:41 IST at Calicut International Airport - Kozhikode, India. The Boeing 737-800 aircraft was unable to stop on the remaining wet runway, departed the runway and airport safety area at about 41 knots, falling down about 110 feet off the table-top type airport. Nineteen passengers were fatally injured and seventy five passengers suffered serious injuries. Ninety passengers suffered minor injuries. Both pilots suffered fatal injuries, one cabin crew member was seriously injured and three cabin crew received minor injuries. The presentation will provide insights into the accident: airport environment, aircraft damage, cockpit and cabin seat performance, injury location map, and associated injury types.
