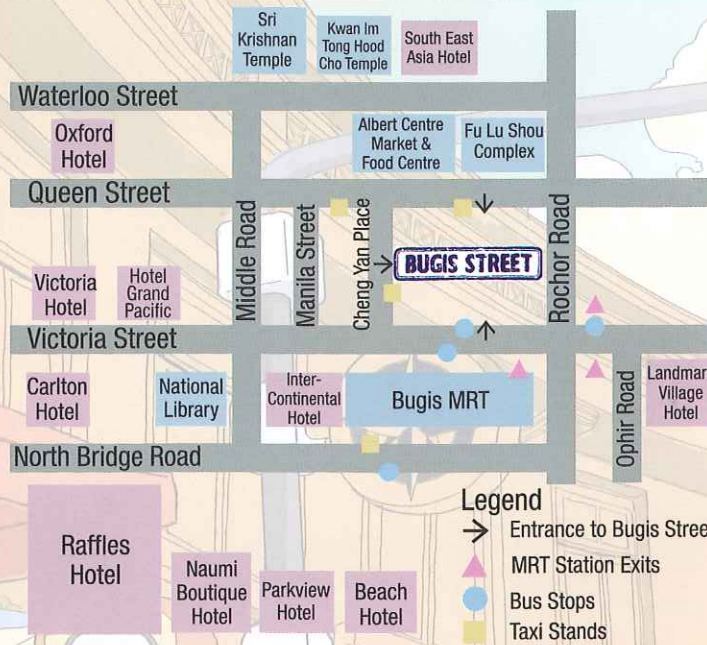
Bugis Street is an iconic shopping location, which boasts 800 concept shops and counting! It is an experience you absolutely cannot miss!

Bugis Street in the 1950s was infamous internationally for its notorious night activities. Flamboyant transvestites would walk the streets, attracting sailors and military personnel on shore leave. The entire area came alive in the evenings as push carts gathered, offering a wide selection of cheap goods and hawker food, hence earning its name of "Pasar Malam" or Night Market.

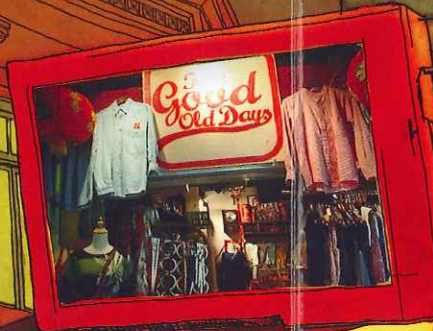
